How to choose a plan that includes Hoag

Step		What to Do
1	Review Your Employer's Offers	Ask HR or your benefits portal if your options include plans contracted with Hoag. Even if your plan type is accepted, you must confirm that Hoag is in-network.
2	Check Accepted Plans	Visit Hoag's Accepted Health Plans page to verify your plan type (PPO, HMO, EPO, etc.) is supported. This ensures you won't face out-of-network penalties or unexpected coverage gaps.
3	Select Hoag as Your Preferred Hospital (HMO Only)	If enrolling in an HMO, explicitly choose Hoag Hospital as your preferred provider. This is required in many HMO plans to guarantee access.
4	Contact Your Insurance Plan (If Unsure)	When in doubt, call Member Services (the number on your card) to confirm Hoag is in-network. Direct confirmation puts your access in writing—no surprises later.
5	Special Notes for Seniors	If you're under Medicare or Medicare Advantage, consider attending Hoag's free Medicare classes to compare plan options. Plans change annually—this helps ensure you stay covered at Hoag.
6	Need Help?	Call Hoag's Personal Service Team at (800) 400-4624. They can assist with provider listings, plan details, and next steps.
